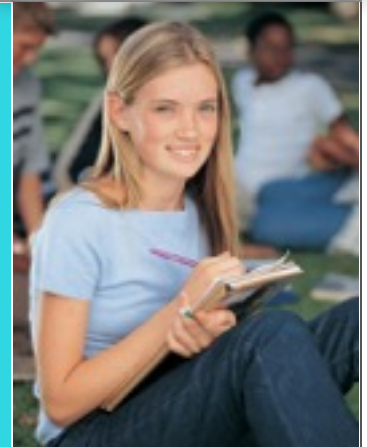

summer program ✨ class descriptions

✨ **Ready, Set, Read! (Orton-Gillingham Early Reading Readiness)**

Using Orton-Gillingham, this class lays the foundation needed to break the early written code for children in grades K or 1 who are not acquiring typical reading & writing development via traditional education methods and/or have a positive family history of dyslexia.

✨ **Code Busters (Orton-Gillingham Reading Decoding & Spelling Intervention)**

Using Orton-Gillingham (the true & tried approach to treating dyslexia), Code Busters retrains the brain with sequential & systematic rule-based strategies that break the written code and make reading decoding, sight word recognition, spelling, & reading fluency more automatic & efficient.

✨ **Writing S.O.S. (Sentence to Paragraph to Essay Writing)**

Using a systematic & leveled approach to writing, students learn how to structure their thoughts at the basic sentence and paragraph levels first. With the foundation in place, students learn to expand their writing while learning to write a variety of paragraph kinds (example, reason, persuasion, narration, & compare/contrast). Students progress to the essay level while targeting similar essay kinds. Last, students develop their ability to proofread & edit their essays by learning the rules for punctuation, capitalization, tense, & verb agreement. ✨ **Text Forensics (Oral Retell, Reading Comprehension, & Critical Thinking)**

TF Fiction: targets oral retell, comprehension, & critical thinking of fiction text. This class is ideal for younger students in grades 1-3 or for students (of any age) with weak expressive language skills.

TF Non-Fiction: targets comprehension & critical thinking of non-fiction text with heavy emphasis on reading comprehension test-taking strategies. This class is ideal for students in grades 3 or higher.

TF Response to Reading: targets text analysis & gathering of evidence in order to write logical arguments, explanations, and narratives based on claims, solid reasoning, & relevant evidence.

✨ **F.O.R.C.E. (Growth Mindset & Executive Function Skills)**

Students learn the power of positive growth mindset coupled with critical executive function skills (the ability to plan, organize, prioritize, self-monitor, sustain attention & persist) in order to successfully execute goals, assignments, and projects to completion and on time.

✨ **S.M.A.R.T. (Study, Note-Taking, & Test-Taking Strategies)**

Students learn strategies to improve their study, note-taking, and test-taking skills needed to perform well on academic testing.

✨ **P.E.A.C.E. (Social Thinking® , Emotional Regulation, & Language)**

Using the framework of Social Thinking®, this class teaches students to monitor their thoughts, emotions, & actions and adjust them accordingly to meet the expected demands of a given situation.

✨ **Speech & Language (Speech, Expressive & Receptive Language & Fluency)**

Lemon Tree is a comprehensive speech-language therapy practice offering services in expressive and receptive language disorders, speech delays, language processing difficulties, & fluency disorders.

Response to the Coronavirus

The Summer Program will be **physically conducted at Lemon Tree** with **extensive safety measures** in place that comply with CDC, OSHA, and FL Department of Health guidelines.

Getting Started

A **first time admissions screening** is mandatory and the first step for new students. The admissions screening includes a review of your child's records, a parent & child consultation, and a comprehensive screening which will help the therapist create a treatment plan specific to your child's needs as well as develop matching criteria for potential group instruction. **The deadline for registration is April 15 ; therefore, new students are strongly encouraged to start the screening & registration process February-March to ensure placement in the program!**

Registration for the Summer Program

Registration occurs **on-site by appointment only** so that we may provide you maximum support. **New Student Registration** extends **Feb 1 - April 15**, either following your child's first-time admissions screening (time permitting) or during a scheduled appointment.

Matching Criteria For Camp & Workshops

Students are **carefully** grouped according to matched objectives, skill level, age, and scheduling availability. The number of students per camp ranges from 2-4 students. The option of camp or workshop may not be available for every child. If camp or workshop is not available or desired for your child, Lemon Tree will offer you individual instruction (10 session minimum).

Attendance Requirement

Attendance is **mandatory** for the entire duration in which you enroll. There are **no reimbursements & no make-ups** for missed classes (planned or unplanned).

Payment Schedule

A **non-refundable deposit of \$300 (applied towards your summer tuition) is required for enrollment**. You will be provided with your child's final summer schedule by **mid-May** at which point the remaining **balance of your child's total summer tuition will be due/drafted**.
